**WHEREAS**, Sangamon County will accept jurisdiction and maintenance of Old U.S. Route 66 (Panhandle Road) from 0.2 mile north of New City Road (CH 40) north to the edge of pavement of East Lake Shore Drive, this also includes both legs of the "Y", in its entirety, in its present condition; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Department of Transportation will pay Sangamon County a lump sum total of \$712,000.00 per the agreement identified as State Job Number C-96-205-05 and Sangamon County Section 04-00001-00-JT and PPS Number 6-08340-0100 (FY05); and,

**WHEREAS**, the \$712,000.000 will be deposited in the County Motor Fuel Tax account.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County, at its **REGULAR STATUTORY MEETING**, assembled this 14<sup>th</sup> day of June, A.D., 2005 that the Sangamon County Board Chairman is authorized to enter into an agreement with the State of Illinois, acting through its Department of Transportation, to accept jurisdiction of the above-state route in Sangamon County and to sign said agreement.
