

Resolution 13-1

Whereas, the Sangamon County Department of Buildings & Grounds is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the three (3) Parking areas that serve the Sangamon County Complex and to insure their continued useful life and servicibility; and,

Whereas, the current paved areas are over 14 years old and now require routine maintenance and repair in the form a re-surfacing procedure and re stripping to remain functional; and,

Whereas the this maintenance and the age of the pavement makes it reasonable to consider this re-surfacing procedure and maintain and extend the useful life of the parking areas as opposed to replacing them; and,

Whereas, bids were sought for the re-surfacing and re-stripping of these parking areas and with Merrill Contractors Inc. submitting the lowest responsible bid of \$54,000.00 for a Slurry Seal surfacing System; and,

Whereas, this bid meets the necessary specifications for this piece of work; and,

Whereas, at their July 31st, 2006 meeting, the Public Building Commission of Springfield, Sangamon County, Illinois approved using funds from the 1990 Surplus to fund this project; and,

Now therefore be it resolved by the County Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session on this 8<sup>th</sup> Day of August, 2006 that the project of Slurry Seal re-surfacing by Merrill's Contractors Inc. is hereby approved, and the funding of this purchase coming from the 1990 Surplus Funds of the Public Building Commission of Springfield, Sangamon County, Illinois is authorized.
