

RESOLUTION 12-1

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5-25001 of the Counties Code (55 ILCS 5/5-25001) the County of Sangamon has an established county health department; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that consolidated health department could more efficiently serve the needs of the citizens of both units of government; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City, by referendum, desire that their local health department be abandoned pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-25009; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board of Health and Sangamon County Board have committed to adopting the City's fee schedule for food establishments and retail food stores as part of this consolidation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, at its Regular Reconvened Adjourned September Session, assembled this 1st day of February, 2006, the Sangamon County Board accepts the recommendation of the Sangamon County Board of Health and hereby deletes Schedule A of Title 5, Chapter 5.20, Food Service Establishments and replaces it with the revised Schedule A as attached. This resolution shall become effective June 1, 2006.

Food Establishments Schedule A

I. Food Service Establishment Operator's License

Category I	\$185
Category II	\$150
Category III	\$ 75
Temporary	\$ 25 for the first day and \$10 for each day thereafter
Seasonal	\$ 80
Day Care	\$ 20
Plan Review Fee	\$200
New Facility/Owner	\$100
Not-for-profit	\$ 0

A. Late Fees shall be assessed in addition to the license fee in the following manner:

1. License applications and renewal fees received 15 to 30 days after the annual license effective date shall pay a late fee in an amount equivalent to one times the annual license fee.
2. License applications and renewal fees received 31 to 45 days after the annual license effective date shall pay a late fee in an amount equivalent to one and one-half times the annual license fee.
3. License applications and renewal fees received 46 or more days after the annual license effective date shall pay a late fee in an amount equivalent to two times the annual license fee.

B. Penalties for violations and re-inspection fees shall be assessed as follows:

1. Non-Critical violations: warning
2. Critical violations: fine up to \$25 per violation
3. 1st re-inspection - \$25
4. 2nd re-inspection - \$100
5. 3rd - 5th re-inspection - \$250
6. 6th or more re-inspection - \$250 plus the following year's License Fee shall be increased by 50%

C. Those facilities that have been awarded a Gold Certificate (or successor achievement program) will receive a rebate in the amount of 5% of the regular license fee for the first year, 10% for the second year, and 20% for each year thereafter.

II. Retail Food Store Operator's License

Retail Food Store A	\$300
Retail Food Store B	\$200
Retail Food Store C	\$ 35

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1. License applications and renewal fees received 15 to 30 days after the annual license effective date shall pay a late fee in an amount equivalent to one times the annual license fee.
2. License applications and renewal fees received 31 to 45 days after the annual license effective date shall pay a late fee in an amount equivalent to one and one-half times the annual license fee.
3. License applications and renewal fees received 46 or more days after the annual license effective date shall pay a late fee in an amount equivalent to two times the annual license fee.

B. Penalties for violations and re-inspection fees shall be assessed as follows:

1. Non-Critical violations: warning
2. Critical violations: fine up to \$25 per violation
3. 1st Reinspection - \$25
4. 2nd Reinspection - \$100
5. 3rd - 5th Reinspection - \$250
6. 6th or more Reinspection - \$250 plus the following year's License Fee shall be increased by 50%

C. Those facilities that have been awarded a Gold Certificate (or successor achievement program) will receive a rebate in the amount of 5% of the regular license fee for the first year, 10% for the second year, and 20% for each year thereafter.
