

Resolution 160-1

Whereas, the Sangamon County Board adopted the Sangamon County Employee Voluntary Severance Plan to preserve the future financial stability of Sangamon County; and,

Whereas, the Sangamon County Auditor's Office has been charged with administering the Voluntary Severance Plan and calculating the cost savings attributed to individuals who take advantage of the plan; and,

Whereas, each department that had employees participate in the plan were asked to propose an operational reorganization that achieved, to the best of their abilities, the goals of the plan; and,

Whereas, after a thorough analysis by the Sangamon County Auditor's Office and review by the Sangamon County Board Finance Committee a comprehensive financial analysis on the Voluntary Severance Plan and resulting department reorganization was developed and is attached to this resolution; and,

Whereas, the Sangamon County Voluntary Severance Plan and the resulting reorganization has resulted in an ongoing, annual savings in excess of \$800,000; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SANGAMON COUNTY BOARD IN SESSION THIS 10TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2006, THAT THE COMPREHENSIVE FINANCIAL ANALYSIS AND DEPARTMENT REORGANIZATIONS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SANGAMON COUNTY EMPLOYEE VOLUNTARY SEVERANCE PLAN IS HEREBY APPROVED, AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE SANGAMON COUNTY BOARD RECOGNIZES THE HARD WORK AND DEDICATION OF THE SANGAMON COUNTY ELECTED OFFICIALS, SANGAMON COUNTY DEPARTMENT HEADS, AND SANGAMON COUNTY STAFF THAT CONTRIBUTED TO THIS REORGANIZATION AND HAS RESULTED IN AN ANNUAL SAVINGS OF \$800,000.
