Whereas, the Sangamon County Board has determined that a review of operations of the Supervisor of Assessments Office, Information Systems Department, Recorder's Office, and the Juvenile Probation and Court Services Department is needed to ensure that all known operational efficiencies are being utilized; and,

Whereas, an operational/efficiency study on some county offices and departments was last performed in 1999 and resulted in several valuable recommendations; and,

Whereas, preparation and planning for the Fiscal Year 2007 budget is currently underway and it is most efficient to make operational adjustments at the beginning of the new fiscal year; and,

Whereas, MAXIMUS, Inc. has submitted a proposal for performing the operational efficiency study with the total cost being \$26,000; and,

Whereas, MAXIMUS, Inc. performed the operational efficiency study for Sangamon County in 1999 and has performed similar studies for several counties in the State of Illinois; and,

Whereas, Sangamon County has been satisfied with the services received from MAXIMUS, Inc.; and,

Now therefore be it resolved by the members of the Sangamon County Board in session this 13<sup>th</sup> Day of June, 2006, that the proposal by MAXIMUS, Inc. for the performance of a operational efficiency study is approved and the payment not to exceed \$26,000 for performing such services is approved.
