

RESOLUTION NO. 14-1

**WHEREAS**, in June, 2002, Sangamon County adopted an Administrative Hearing Officer Ordinance to provide for the efficient enforcement of certain county ordinances through the administrative adjudication of violations; and


**WHEREAS**, at that time, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health had not merged with the Springfield Health Department, and at the time was not responsible for enforcement of certain public health-related ordinances within the City limits of Springfield; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 1, 2006, the City and County Health Departments merged, with the County assuming responsibility for enforcing certain public health-related ordinances within the City limits of Springfield; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sangamon County Administrative Hearing Officer Ordinance needs to be amended to provide for the efficient enforcement of certain county and city ordinances as they are related to public health;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 14<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2006, that the first paragraph of Section 5.30.020 of Chapter 5.30 of the Sangamon County Code is amended to read:

“Code” means any county ordinance that pertains to or regulates any of the following: animal control; the definition, identification, and abatement of public nuisances; the accumulation, disposal, and transportation of garbage, refuse and other forms of solid waste; the construction and maintenance of buildings and structures; sanitation practices, zoning, smoking, or City of Springfield ordinances relating to public health, animal control, or as agreed to be enforced by the Sangamon County Board and the Sangamon County Board of Health.
