## RESOLUTION NO 16-1

WHEREAS, the County of Sangamon has authority pursuant to 70 ILCS 705/3.1 to enact a comprehensive fire protection plan for unincorporated territory without fire protection in Sangamon County; and

WHEREAS, territory in unincorporated Sangamon County is without fire protection so that placement within a fire protection district will be conducive to the promotion and protection of the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board has held public hearing pursuant to statutory notice requirements upon the proposed comprehensive fire protection plan, a copy of said plan being available for review in the Sangamon County Board Office, 200 S. 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 201, Springfield, Illinois 62701 and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, on April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2005, the majority of electors in Sangamon County voted for authorizing the Sangamon County Board to adopt a comprehensive fire protection plan; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County has held public discussion with delegates from the various fire protection districts serving the citizens of Sangamon County regarding adoption of a practical and comprehensive fire protection plan for Sangamon County;

WHEREAS, 70 ILCS 705/3.1 provides for amendments to the comprehensive fire protection plan from time to time as properties become eligible for inclusion in a fire protection district; and,
