

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health (SCDPH) agreed to not increase fees for the first two years of the merger of the City and County Health Departments; and

WHEREAS, the County will continue to honor that agreement until the expiration of the first 2-year period, which will be March 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health needs to review actual cost for provision of services since the merger; and

WHEREAS, the most recent fee study for SCDPH was conducted in 2005 prior to the merger; and

WHEREAS, SCDPH now offers 30 additional services that were not reviewed in the previous fee analysis; and

WHEREAS, Maximus, Inc. conducted the last fee study for SCDPH in 2005, and subsequently understands the operations of the health department and has an established baseline for comparison of previous costs; and

WHEREAS, establishing fees in accordance with actual cost is a priority for the County because of property tax caps; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board of Health recommends a fee study be conducted for the Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 11th day of December, 2007, that the County enter into an agreement with Maximus, Inc. in the amount of \$14,000.00 to perform and complete a fee study for the Sangamon County Department of Public Health.
