

Resolution 17-1

Whereas, Sangamon County has determined that the implementation of a Geographic Information System (GIS) is necessary for the effective administration of County functions; and

whereas, it is necessary for the GIS Division of the Sangamon County Information Systems department to acquire new aerial photography every four (4) years as specified in the various intergovernmental agreements that the County has entered into with the city of Springfield and other villages located within Sangamon County; and

Whereas, it is necessary for topography (contours, digital terrain models and spot elevations) to be acquired to complete the GIS Base layers as defined in said intergovernmental agreements; and

Whereas, it is also necessary for the planimetric data (Building footprints, roads, sidewalks, parking lots etc) to be updated where change has occurred since the April, 2003 aerial photography was acquired; and

Whereas, Sangamon County solicited Statements of Qualifications from qualified Aerial photography firms and conducted interviews of the three top qualified firms and selected the Sanborn Map Company located in Chesterfield, Missouri for this project;

Whereas, it is necessary to enter into a contract with the Sanborn Map Company to perform said services in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Forty Six Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty dollars (\$846,860.00); and
