**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING  
RESTRICTIONS AS TO THE PARKING OF MOTOR OR OTHER VEHICLES  
UPON ANY COUNTY ROAD WAY OR RIGHT-OF-WAY.**

**WHEREAS**, the County Board of Sangamon County is willing to consider the establishment of parking restricted areas along County Highways in Sangamon County defined as follows:

Parking on county roadway or right-of-way:

- (a) The County Highway Department with respect to county highways under its jurisdiction may place signs prohibiting, limiting, or restricting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on any county highway where in its opinion such stopping, standing or parking is dangerous to those using the highway or where the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic thereon.
- (b) The county engineer is authorized to identify certain "No Parking, Stopping, or Standing" areas on roadways under the county's jurisdiction and bring those locations to the Road and Bridge Committee of the County Board of Sangamon County for approval prior to installing the signs.
- (c) A copy of this section shall be maintained within the office of the county engineer for inspection by interested persons.
- (d) Every person who violates any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of \$25 for each violation provided that for the second or subsequent violation within a calendar year shall be punished by a fine of \$50.00 for each violation. Each day a violation continues shall constitute a separate punishable offense.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County, at its **Regular Reconvened Adjourned September Session** assembled this 9<sup>th</sup> day of October, A.D., 2007 that the ordinance as established above is hereby approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the first paragraph of Section 5.30.020 of Chapter 5.30 of the Sangamon County Code is amended to read:

"Code" means any county ordinance that pertains to or regulates any of the following: animal control; the definition, identification, and abatement of public nuisances; the accumulation, disposal, and transportation of garbage, refuse and other forms of solid waste; the construction and maintenance of buildings and structures; sanitation practices, zoning, smoking, no parking ordinances, or City of Springfield ordinances relating to public health, animal control, or as agreed to be enforced by the Sangamon County Board and the Sangamon County Board of Health.
