

SANGAMON COUNTY  
ORDINANCE 8-1

ORDINANCE ADDING TERRITORY TO THE LINCOLN-  
LOGAN COUNTY ENTERPRISE ZONE

WHEREAS, Lincoln, Logan, Elkhart and Sangamon (“Units of Government”) each adopted respective ordinances, as amended, establishing and designating an Enterprise Zone encompassing contiguous portions of Logan, Lincoln, Elkhart and Sangamon (such zone, as amended, being the “Enterprise Zone”);

WHEREAS, the Units of Government each entered into an intergovernmental agreement, as amended, which identifies the responsibilities of each party;

WHEREAS, The County of DeWitt desires to become part of the Enterprise Zone;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY OF SANGAMON, ILLINOIS THAT**

**Section 1** – The Legal Description of Zone described in adopted respective ordinances the area Enterprise Zone is hereby amended by adding additional property to the Zone as described in Attachment A attached, hereto and incorporated herein.

**Section 2** – The Intergovernmental Agreement between Units of Government adopted, as amended, is hereby amended to include The County of DeWitt, and additional property to the Zone as described in Attachment A

**Section 3** – The County of Sangamon hereby establishes an Enterprise Zone within the County of Dewitt, said Enterprise Zone being a portion of a larger Enterprise Zone, encompassing contiguous portions of the County of Sangamon, the Village of Elkhart, the City of Lincoln, the County of Logan and the County of DeWitt.

Section 5 – This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law, and from and after the designation by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity of said additional territory and unit of government contained herein as part of the Lincoln-Logan County Enterprise Zone.

**LINCOLN LOGAN ENTERPRISE ZONE**

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Adding Monsanto Property and Lincoln Sites

June 4, 2008

Site A – Beginning at a point of the Lincoln Logan County Enterprise Zone at the intersection of N Union Street and Lincoln Parkway, thence northerly on N Union Street to Interstate 55 (1.11 mi), thence easterly along Interstate 55 to 1400<sup>th</sup> Ave (2.01 mi), thence southerly along 1400<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Business 55 (0.581 mi), Westerly along Business 55 to a point at the intersection of Kickapoo Street and Lincoln Parkway, (0.652 mi), thence southerly and westerly along Lincoln Parkway and encompassing the area within to the intersection of N Union Street and Lincoln Parkway (1.75 mi) [Total Area 2.00 mi x 1.35 mi – 2.7 sq mi]

Site B – Beginning at a point where the Lincoln Logan County Enterprise Zone intersects N Union Street between 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and 21<sup>st</sup> Street, thence easterly 300 yards to a point, thence southerly 300 yards to a point, thence westerly to N. Union Street and encompassing the area within to the point of origin [Total Area 300 yards x 300 yards]

Site C – Beginning at a point of the Lincoln Logan County Enterprise Zone at the intersection of N McLean Street and State Route 10, thence north easterly on N McLean street to Burlington Street, Thence north westerly on Burlington Street to the Illinois Central Rail Road line, thence south westerly along the Illinois Central Rail Road Line to Burlington Street and encompassing the area within to the intersection of N McLean Street and Burlington Street [ Total area 302 yards x 127 yards]

Site D – Beginning at a point of the Lincoln Logan County Enterprise Zone at the intersection of Washington Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Street, thence easterly to Madison Street, thence southerly 54.2 yards to a point, thence westerly to Washington Street, thence northerly encompassing the area within to the point of origin [Total area 194 yards x 54.2 yards]

Site E – Beginning at a point of the Lincoln Logan County Enterprise Zone at the southernmost point on Illinois Business 55, thence southerly 419 yards, thence westerly 0.319 miles, thence northerly 419 yards encompassing the area within to the point of origin.

Site F Monsanto Farmer City – Beginning at the northern most part of the Lincoln Logan County Enterprise Zone that intersects with 1950<sup>th</sup> Street a three foot wide strip of land begins and then commences, thence easterly and then northerly along 1950<sup>th</sup> Street to 1968<sup>th</sup> Street (4.09 mi), thence easterly on 1968<sup>th</sup> Street to 2000<sup>th</sup> Avenue (0.485 mi), thence northerly on 2000<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 2025<sup>th</sup> Avenue (234 yds), thence northerly on 2025<sup>th</sup> Avenue to CR-2025E (344 yds), thence easterly and then northerly on CR-2025E to County Road 2027N (0.287 mi), thence easterly on County Road 2027N to 2150<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 2050<sup>th</sup> Street (1.25 mi), thence northerly then easterly on 2050<sup>th</sup> Street to 2250<sup>th</sup> Avenue (1.12 mi), thence southerly on 2250<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 2000<sup>th</sup> Street (0.488 mi), thence easterly on 2000<sup>th</sup> Street to CR-2400 E (1.47 mi), thence northerly on CR-2400 E to 1100 Road N (90 yds), thence easterly on 1100 Road N to State Route 17 (1.19 mi), thence southerly on State Route 17 to 1100 Road N 158 yds), thence easterly on 1100 Road N to 180 Road E (0.776 mi), thence northerly on 180 Road E to E 1100 North Road(136 yds), thence easterly on E 1100 North Road to a point (7.50 mi), thence southerly to a point (0.250 mi), thence easterly to 1000E (0.674 mi), thence northerly on 1000E to 1100N (0.261 mi), thence easterly on 1100 N to 1350 E (3.59 mi), thence northerly on 1350 E to Illinois Route 10 (0.666 mi), thence easterly on Illinois Route 10 to N 2225 Rd E (8.68 mi), thence northerly on N2225 Rd E to E 1350 Rd N (1.51 mi), thence easterly on E1350 Rd N to 2250 Rd N (437 yds), thence northerly on 2250 Rd N to 1400 N (0.481mi), thence easterly on 1400N to 2450 Rd E(2.0 mi), thence northerly on 2450 Rd E to

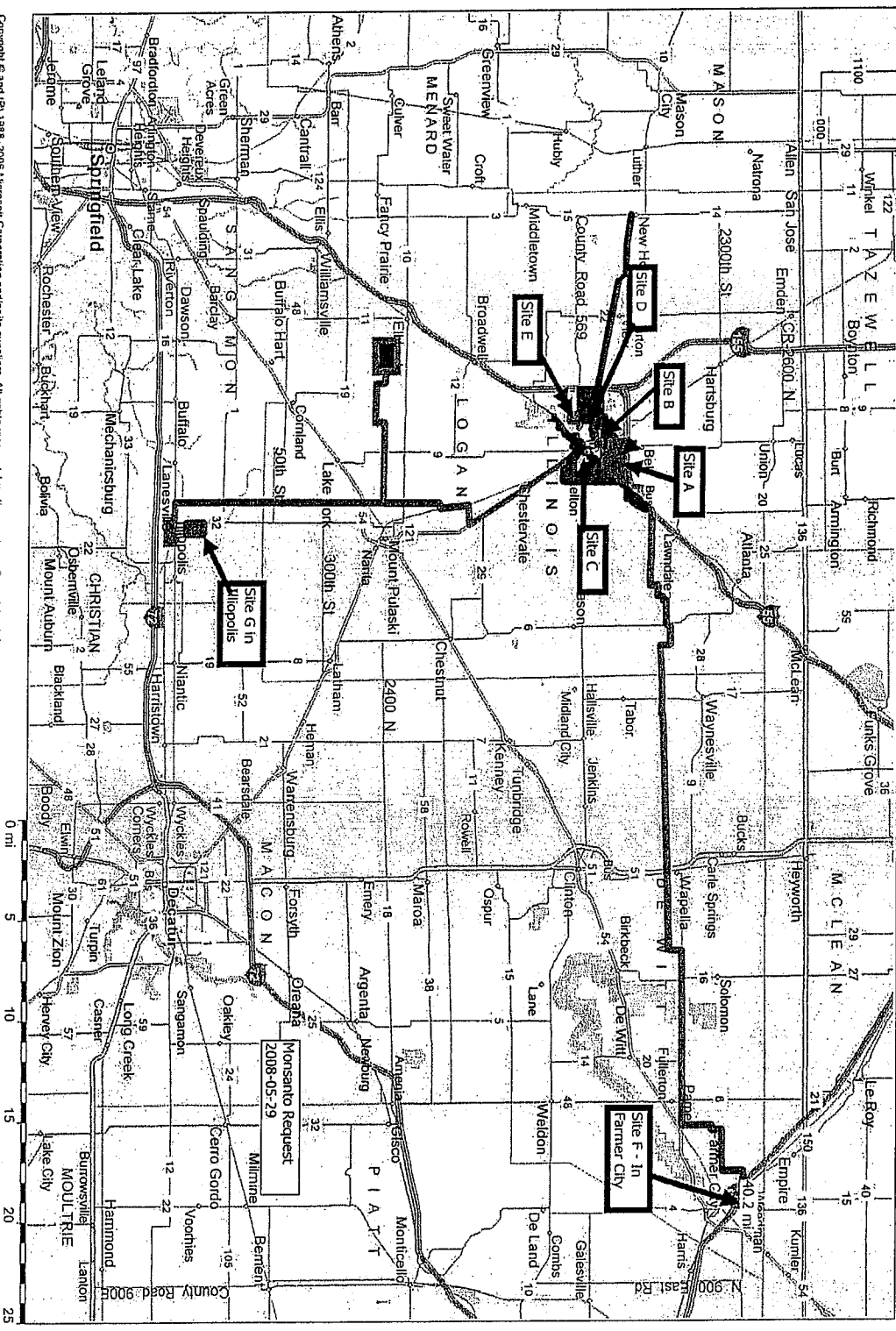
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E1500 Rd N (1.00 mi), thence easterly on E1500 Rd N to Illinois Route 150 (0.986 mi), thence southerly on Illinois Route 150 to Interstate I-74 (0.389 mi), thence easterly along Interstate 74 to Illinois Route 22 (0.547 mi), thence northerly on Illinois Route 22 to a point (0.500 mi), thence westerly to a point (0.300 mi), thence southerly encompassing the area within to Interstate I-74 (0.455 mi).

Site G – Monsanto Illiopolis – Beginning at a point of the Lincoln Logan County Enterprise Zone at the intersection of N. Mt. Pulaski Road and Old Route 36, thence northerly 0.44 miles to a point, thence easterly 0.596 miles to a point, thence northerly 1.00 miles to a point, thence southerly to the point of origin encompassing the area within. [Total area 1.00 mi x 0.5960 miles]
