

RESOLUTION NUMBER 6-1

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services, has established the Joint Purchasing Program, a voluntary program allowing local governments to save time and money when purchasing many commonly acquired commodities, services and equipment items; and

WHEREAS, Central Management Services estimates that local governments may save more than 20 percent on purchases made through the Joint Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County departments purchase items that may be included in statewide procurement contracts awarded by the Joint Purchasing Program, and departments may be able to realize savings in the purchase of such items by participating in the Program; and

WHEREAS, Central Management Services requires the governing boards of local governments wishing to register for the Joint Purchasing Program to enact resolutions authorizing program participation by its purchasing officials; and

WHEREAS, there are no fees to register for the Joint Purchasing Program and Program registration does not obligate the County to procure any items from the statewide contracts established by Central Management Services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this day of August 11, 2009, that voluntary participation in the Joint Purchasing Program administered by the Illinois Department of Central Management Services is authorized from the date of this resolution until such time as the Department is given written notice that this resolution is revoked, and that the County Administrator is authorized to execute all necessary forms, applications, requisitions and other documents related to this Program.
