

RESOLUTION NO. 40-1

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE ENTERING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD AND SANGAMON COUNTY
FOR THE PROVISION OF ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Article 7 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois and Section 3 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/3) provide that a public agency may enter into an intergovernmental agreement with other public agencies to obtain services; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 200/1 et seq., governmental units of the State of Illinois are permitted to enter into Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements for any lawful purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield and County of Sangamon previously executed an intergovernmental agreement for animal control services; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health is the designated agent that administers and oversees animal control functions as defined in the Illinois Animal Control Act and County ordinances attendant thereto by the County of Sangamon; and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need to remove stray or straying dogs and other animals subject to impoundment from within the City of Springfield upon the request of the City and,

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health has the capacity to provide such services through its Animal Control Center; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield has approved an ordinance authorizing the extension of an agreement authorizing payments as referenced in Exhibit A for animal control services provided by the Department from the dates provided in Exhibit A;





AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS BOARD OF HEALTH FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR FY2024 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$284,031.28, FOR THE OFFICE OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City council previously passed ordinance number 016-01-21 authorizing an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with the Sangamon County Board of Health for Animal Control Services from March 1, 2020, through February 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City council previously passed ordinance number 091-03-21 authorizing an extension of an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with the Sangamon County Board of Health for Animal Control Services from March 1, 2020, through February 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County Board of Health for Animal Control Services would like to extend the contract by one year for services from March 1, 2023, through February 29, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County Board of Health for Animal Control Services is willing and able to provide these services for reimbursement of a share of these expenses not to exceed \$284,031.28; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to extend the agreement and authorize payment for FY2024 in the amount of \$284,031.28 to reimburse the County for a share of Animal Control Services expenses; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the agreement shall be located in the Office of the City Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby approves and authorizes the execution of a one year extension of the Intergovernmental Cooperation agreement between the City of Springfield and the Sangamon County Board of Health for Animal Control Services from March 1, 2023, through February 29, 2024.


Section 2: That the Office of Budget and Management is hereby authorized to make payment to the Springfield Sangamon County Board of Health (OSAN6099) in an amount not to exceed \$284,031.28 from account number 001-107-GENC-VARI-1232 in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and recording by the City Clerk.

**EXTENSION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SANGAMON AND THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD
REGARDING ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES**

This parties to this agreement are Sangamon County (hereinafter the "County") and the City of Springfield (hereinafter the "City").

WHEREAS, in 2021, the parties entered into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement Between the County of Sangamon and the City of Springfield Regarding Animal Control Services whose term expired February 28, 2023 (see Exhibit 1); and

WHEREAS, through this agreement, the parties desire to set forth the terms upon which the County provides animal control services for the City for an additional year.


WHEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. The County will provide animal control services to the City through February 29, 2024, and the parties will continue to perform in accordance with the terms of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement (Exhibit 1).
2. For animal control services provided from March 1, 2023, through February 29, 2024, the City agrees to pay the Department \$284,031.28 by November 1, 2023. This fee covers the cost of the previous year's actual animal control services rendered to the City during its last fiscal year. (Exhibit 2).

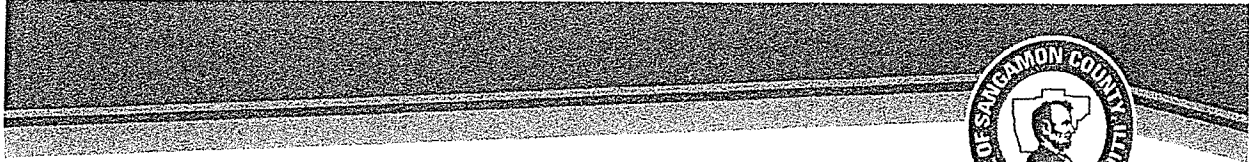
