

RESOLUTION 20-1

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Illinois Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/28-1 et seq., and the Illinois Counties Code, 55 ILCS 5/5-1005.5, the county board of a county has the authority to submit an advisory question of public policy to the electors of the county by means of a referendum; and

WHEREAS, The County Board hereby intends to submit to the residents of the County of Sangamon an advisory question of public and county-wide significance; and

WHEREAS, The County Board believes it is in the best interests of the residents of the County of Sangamon to move as expeditiously as possible to submit this proposition to the voters at the next regularly scheduled election, to be held on November 5, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Members of the Board of Sangamon County in session this 13th day of August, 2024 that:

Section 1. The above recitals are expressly incorporated herein and made part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The County Board of Sangamon County does hereby initiate and authorize the following advisory question of public policy to be submitted to the voters of the entire County of Sangamon at the regularly scheduled election next occurring after the effective date of this resolution, on , November 5, 2024:
