WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of CASA of Sangamon County wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts for the Dual Status Youth Initiative program in the amount of approximately \$33,876; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow CASA of Sangamon County to provide improved identification of and services for dual status youth; to bridge the gap between juvenile justice & child welfare systems.; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, the Finance Committee has approved the CASA of Sangamon County Department's request to apply for the Dual Status Youth Initiative grant and the committee recommends that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 13th day of August, 2024, approves the acceptance of the Dual Status Youth Initiative grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts. The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.
