WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from Illinois Department of Human Services for the Reimagine Public Safety Act Violence Prevention grant program in the amount of approximately \$639,500.00; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow Public Health to provide violence prevention services in collaboration with other agencies to benefit the Sangamon community; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, the Finance Committee has approved the Public Health Department's request to apply for the Reimagine Public Safety Act Violence Prevention grant and the committee recommends that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by Illinois Department of Human Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 10th day of December, 2024, approves the acceptance of the Reimagine Public Safety Act Violence Prevention grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by Illinois Department of Human Services. The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.
