WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Sheriff's Office wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from Illinois Law Enforcement Alarm System (ILEAS) for the Less Lethal Alternatives for Law Enforcement Grant program in the amount of approximately \$239,167; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow the Sheriff's Office to provide 111 Taser 10s to Sheriff's Office Personnel; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, the Jail Committee and the Finance Committee have approved the the Sheriff's Office Department's request to apply for the Less Lethal Alternatives for Law Enforcement grant and the committees recommend that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by Illinois Law Enforcement Alarm System (ILEAS).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 9th day of July, 2024, approves the acceptance of the Less Lethal Alternatives for Law Enforcement grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by Illinois Law Enforcement Alarm System (ILEAS). The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.
