WHEREAS, the City and the County desire to complete the construction of the HUB which includes a parking garage for Amtrak passengers, County employees, County Building visitors, and Sangamon Mass Transit District (SMTD) employees; an Amtrak Station including platforms and cart paths; a pedestrian bridge across the rail corridor connecting the Amtrak Station to the SMTD facility, and a pedestrian bridge connecting the Amtrak Station and the east platform to be constructed; and,

**WHEREAS**, and Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for Construction of the Springfield-Sangamon County Transportation Center, Rail Platforms, Cart Paths, and Pedestrian Bridges between the City of Springfield and Sangamon County has been prepared; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County, at its Annual Statutory Meeting, assembled this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June, A.D., 2024 that the *Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for Construction of the Springfield-Sangamon County Transportation Center, Rail Platforms, Cart Paths, and Pedestrian Bridges between the City of Springfield and Sangamon County is approved; and,*

#### AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH SANGAMON COUNTY FOR THE CONVEYANCE OF PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND A TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT TO THE COUNTY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, USE AND MAINTENANCE OF PLATFORMS, CART PATHS AND PEDESTRIAN BRIDGES FOR THE SPRINGFIELD SANGAMON COUNTY TRANSPORTATION CENTER, FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and Section 3 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1, *et seq.*,) provide that units of local government may contract or otherwise associate among themselves to obtain or share services; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") received an appropriation of \$122 million ("Series 2 Bonds") for the construction of the Springfield Rail Improvements Project ("SRIP"), which includes the construction of the Springfield Sangamon County Transportation Center ("Center"); and

WHEREAS, the City and County desire to complete the construction of the Center which includes a parking garage for Amtrak passengers, County Employees, County Building visitors, and Sangamon Mass Transit District ("SMTD") employees; an Amtrak station including platforms and cart paths; a pedestrian bridge across the rail corridor connecting the Amtrak station to SMTD Facility, and a pedestrian bridge connecting Amtrak station and the east platform to be constructed; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Springfield to enter into an agreement with Sangamon County for the conveyance of three permanent easements and a temporary construction easement to the County for the construction, use and maintenance of platforms, cart paths and pedestrian bridges for the Springfield Sangamon County Transportation Center.

WHEREAS, a copy of the agreement shall be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the City Council hereby authorizes execution of an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with Sangamon County for the conveyance of permanent easements and a temporary construction easement to the County for the construction, use and maintenance of platforms, cart paths and pedestrian bridges for the Springfield Sangamon County Transportation Center. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute any necessary documents on behalf of the City of Springfield.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and recording by the City Clerk.

# INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE SPRINGFIELD SANGAMON COUNTY TRANSPORTATION CENTER, RAIL PLATFORMS, CART PATHS, AND PEDESTRIAN BRIDGES, BETWEEN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD AND SANGAMON COUNTY

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made as of this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_, A.D. 20\_\_\_\_\_, pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq., between the CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS (hereinafter the "City") and the COUNTY OF SANGAMON, State of Illinois (hereinafter the "County").

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Illinois Constitution provides that units of local government may associate among themselves to obtain or share services and to exercise, combine, or transfer any power or function, in any manner not prohibited by law or by ordinance, Ill. Const., Art. VII § 10 (1970); and

WHEREAS, Illinois statutes provide that public agencies may share powers through intergovernmental agreements pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the City is a unit of local government; and

WHEREAS, the County is a unit of local government; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") received an appropriation of \$122 million ("Series B Bonds") for the construction of the Springfield Rail Improvements Project ("SRIP"), which includes the construction of the Springfield Sangamon County Transportation Center ("CENTER"); and

WHEREAS, the City and County desire to complete the construction of the CENTER which includes a parking garage for Amtrak passengers, County employees, County Building visitors, and Sangamon Mass Transit District ("SMTD") employees; an Amtrak station including platforms and cart paths; a pedestrian bridge across the rail corridor connecting the Amtrak station and the Sangamon Mass Transit District Transfer Facility, and a pedestrian bridge connecting the Amtrak station and the east platform to be constructed; and

WHEREAS, the City, County and SMTD executed an Intergovernmental Agreement on December 4, 2020 for the construction of the CENTER (IGA)

WHEREAS, the schedule for completion of the Center, is August 1, 2026.

WHEREAS, the City plans to execute future agreements with IDOT and with the United States Department of Transportation ("USDOT") to construct the Center as part of the SRIP; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to construct platforms and cart paths for the proposed Amtrak station, a pedestrian bridge across the rail corridor connecting the Amtrak station and the Sangamon Mass Transit District Transfer Facility, and a pedestrian bridge across a portion of the rail corridor connecting the Amtrak station and the east platform to be constructed, on and over nearby property owned by the City for construction of the SRIP; and to acquire permanent easements and a temporary construction easement on and over the real property required for the construction of said platforms, cart paths and pedestrian bridges currently owned by the City;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration for the mutual agreements and covenants contained in this Agreement, the City and County agree as follows:

1. <u>Real Property Conveyances</u>. In order to facilitate the construction of the SRIP, the City agrees to make the conveyances of real property described in each Subsection hereinbelow. Such conveyances shall be made for no consideration other than that consideration stated in this Agreement. In each conveyance, the grantor shall deliver conveyance documents in the form of permanent easements and temporary construction easement. The parties hereto agree that all plats, legal descriptions, and other documents necessary for the conveyance of the permanent easements and temporary construction easement shall be prepared by Hanson Professional Services Inc. The City agrees to make the following conveyances within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Agreement:

2. <u>Permanent Easements</u>. The City grants the following permanent construction easements to the County:

- a. The City shall convey to the County by January 1, 2024, that permanent easement identified as Parcel SR0332A-PE as shown on Exhibit A1, being part of Adams Street right of way in the Northeast Quarter of Section 34 in Township 16 North, Range 5 West of the 3rd Principal Meridian. Situated in Sangamon County Illinois. More particularly described in Exhibit A2.
- b. The City shall convey to the County by January 1, 2024, that permanent easement identified as Parcel SR0332B-PE on Exhibit B1, being Part of Lot 9 in Block 2 of J.R. Grays Addition, part of Adams Street right of way, and part of Tenth Street right of way in the Northeast Quarter of Section 34 in Township 16 North, Range 5 West of the 3rd Principal Meridian. Situated in Sangamon County Illinois. More particularly described in Exhibit B2.
- c. The City shall convey to the County by January 1, 2024, that permanent easement identified as Parcel SR0333-PE on Exhibit C1, being part of Lot 8 and Lot 9 in Block 2 of J.R. Grays Addition, part of Lot 9 in Block 8 of J.R. Grays Addition, part of Lot 8 and Lot 9 in Block 18 of Elijah Iles Addition, part of Lot 8 in Block 19 of Elijah Iles Addition, part of Tenth Street right of way between the north line of Washington Street and the south line of Monroe Street and part of the right of way of Washington Street, Adams Street and Monroe Street. all in the Northeast Quarter of Section 34 in Township 16 North, Range 5 West of the 3rd Principal Meridian. Situated in Sangamon County Illinois. More particularly described in Exhibit C2.

3. <u>Temporary Construction Easements</u>. The City grants the following temporary construction easement to the County:

a. A temporary construction easement identified as Parcel SR0332A-TE as shown on Exhibit A, for construction of the pedestrian bridge, being Part of Lot 9, Lot 10 and Lot 11 in Block 2 of J.R. Grays Addition in the Northeast Quarter of Section 34 in Township 16 North, Range 5 West of the 3rd Principal Meridian. Situated in Sangamon County Illinois. More particularly described in Exhibit A3. Norfolk Southern Railway Company will convey this parcel as a permanent easement to Sangamon County upon transfer of title from the City to Norfolk Southern Railway Company per a Construction and Maintenance Agreement between Norfolk Southern Railway Company and the County.

4. <u>Authorization to Enter into Agreement</u>. Each individual executing or attesting to this Agreement on behalf of a respective unit of local government hereby warrants and represents that such individual is authorized to execute or attest and deliver this Agreement pursuant to authority granted by the corporate authorities of the applicable unit of local government on behalf of whom the individual is executing or attesting to this Agreement.

#### 5. <u>Miscellaneous</u>.

a. <u>Severability</u>. If any term, covenant, condition, or provision (or any part thereof) of this Agreement or the application thereof to any party or circumstances shall, at any time or to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement and the application of such term or provision (or remainder thereof), to the parties or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid, or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby, and shall be valid and be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

b. <u>Compliance with Applicable Law</u>. In performance of each party's respective obligations pursuant to this Agreement, the parties shall comply with all applicable provisions of federal, state, and local laws. Any limits or standards set forth in this Agreement to be observed in the performance of the Agreement are minimum requirements and shall not affect the application of more restrictive valid and applicable, federal, state, or local standards to the performance of the Agreement.

c. <u>No Third-Party Beneficiary</u>. This Agreement is intended solely for the benefit of the parties hereto, and it is not the intention of the parties to confer third-party beneficiary rights upon employees, officers, directors, or policyholders of any other person, firm, unit of government, or corporation.

d. <u>Waiver</u>. No failure by any party to insist upon the strict performance of any covenant, duty, agreement, or condition of this Agreement or to exercise any right or remedy consequent upon a breach thereof shall constitute a waiver of any such breach or any other covenant, duty, agreement, or condition.

e. <u>Binding Effect</u>. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors, and assigns.

f. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This document and Exhibits A through C constitute the entire agreement between the parties, and there are no oral agreements or other written agreements. This Agreement may be modified only by a writing executed by all parties hereto.

g. <u>Construction</u>. The parties have participated jointly in the negotiation and drafting of this Agreement. In the event an ambiguity or question of intent or interpretation arises, this Agreement shall be construed as if drafted jointly by the parties and no presumption or burden of proof shall arise favoring or disfavoring any party by virtue of the authorship of any of the provisions of this Agreement.

h. <u>Headings</u>. The headings contained in this Agreement are for convenience of reference only and are in no way intended to describe, interpret, define, or limit the scope, extent, or intent of this Agreement or any provision hereof.

i. <u>Recitals: Terms of Art</u>. The recitals are an integral part of this Agreement and are incorporated herein as if restated in full. Terms of art shall have the meaning so ascribed herein.

j. <u>Relationship of Parties</u>. For the purposes of this Agreement, no party shall be deemed to be an independent contractor, agent, or employee of the other party. No party shall have authority

to make any statements, representations, or commitments of any kind, or to take any action that is binding on the other party, except as explicitly authorized herein.

k. <u>Further Assurances</u>. Each party hereto agrees, as the other party may reasonably request for the purposes of carrying out the intent and purposes of this Agreement, to: (i) furnish upon request to each other party such further information; (ii) to execute and deliver to each other party such other documents, and (iii) to do such other acts and things.

I. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, without regard to the conflicts of law rules thereof. The parties agree that all actions or proceedings arising directly, indirectly or otherwise in connection with this Agreement and the transactions contemplated hereby shall be litigated only in courts having a situs in Sangamon County, Illinois, and hereby consent and submit to the jurisdiction of state Circuit Court located within said county and state.

m. <u>Failure to Perform</u>. In the event any party hereto fails to perform its applicable duties or obligations hereunder, any other party may, at its option, seek specific performance from the party in default, or may exercise its other remedies at law or in equity.

n. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement and any amendment hereto may be executed in any number of counterparts by each party, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, and all of which together shall constitute one document. In proving this Agreement, it shall not be necessary to produce or account for more than one such counterpart signed by the party against whom enforcement is sought. The parties may execute this Agreement by facsimile, scanned Portable Document Format ("PDF"), or other electronically transmitted signature, and such facsimile, scanned PDF, or other electronically transmitted be signatures thereon, shall be treated in all respects as an original instrument bearing an original signature.
