

RESOLUTION NO. 6-1

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE ENTERING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN VILLAGES AND CITIES IN SANGAMON COUNTY AND SANGAMON COUNTY
FOR THE PROVISION OF ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Article 7 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois and Section 3 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/3) provide that a public agency may enter into an intergovernmental agreement with other public agencies to obtain services; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 200/1 et seq., governmental units of the State of Illinois are permitted to enter into Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements for any lawful purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Villages and Cities of Sangamon County and County of Sangamon previously executed an intergovernmental agreement for animal control services; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health is the designated agent that administers and oversees animal control functions as defined in the Illinois Animal Control Act and County ordinances attendant thereto by the County of Sangamon; and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need to remove stray or straying dogs and other animals subject to impoundment from within the Villages and Cities upon the request of the Village or City and,

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health has the capacity to provide such services through its Animal Control Center; and,

WHEREAS, the Villages and Cities referenced in Exhibit A have approved an agreement authorizing payments as references in Exhibit A for animal control services provided by the Department from the dates provided in Exhibit A;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Sangamon County, in session this 12th day of November, 2024, that this Board authorizes entering into agreements with the Villages and Cities for the provision of animal control services as stipulated in Exhibit B.



EXHIBIT B

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES**

This AGREEMENT is entered into by SANGAMON COUNTY, for and on behalf of its Department of Public Health (herein after called the Department) and the «village» (hereinafter called the Village or City) for Animal Control Service.

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Article 7 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois and Section 3 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5ILCS 220/3) provides that a public agency may enter into an intergovernmental agreement with other public agencies to obtain services;

WHEREAS, there is a need to respond to requests for animal control services with the Village; and,

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 200/1 et seq., governmental units of the State of Illinois are permitted to enter into Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements for any lawful purpose; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to remove stray or straying dogs and other animals subject to impoundment from with the Village upon the request of the Village; and,

WHEREAS, the Department has the capacity to provide such services through its Animal Control Center; and,

WHEREAS, the Department, by and through the Sangamon County Department of Public Health, has been designated as the supervising and administrative agent to administer and oversee all animal control functions as defined in the Illinois Animal Control Act and County ordinances attendant thereto by the County of Sangamon; and,

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Department agrees to provide to the «village» the same services as provided by the Sangamon County Animal Control Ordinance.
2. The Department will respond to the request for animal control services only from the Village Police Department. They will not respond to a request from a Village Resident. Villages that do not have 24 hour police coverage may make arrangements with the Director of Public Health for alternative notification protocol.

- 3. For services provided by the Department from «Fiscal_year», the Village agrees to pay the Department the amount of \$«total», payable by (<<Date>>). This fee covers actual animal control officer response, (\$«Response_cost»), boarding costs, (\$«Boarding_cost»), euthanasia (\$«Euthanasia_Cost») and disposal (\$«Disposal_Cost»), for calls and animals impounded in the most recent completed Village Fiscal Year.
- 4. The Department agrees to provide yearly reports to the Village breaking down the number of calls responded to and number of boarding days for impounded animals on the request of the Village Police Department.
- 5. This agreement shall continue in effect from year to year unless terminated by either party giving written notice to the other at least thirty days prior to the annual renewal date.
- 6. This agreement shall become effective upon execution of this agreement by the Mayor or President of the Village and by the Board Chairman, Sangamon County.
