

Local Government Efficiency Reports

Under the Decennial Committees on Local Government Efficiency Act (Public Act 102-1088), certain units of local government in Illinois that have taxing authority—excluding municipalities and counties—are required to form a committee at least once every ten years to evaluate operations and recommend improvements.

These committees are tasked with reviewing the unit's statutes, ordinances, procedures, powers, jurisdiction, shared services, and intergovernmental relationships. A written report summarizing their findings and recommendations for increased efficiency and accountability must be submitted to the County Board within 18 months of the committee's formation.
