RESOLUTION NO. 10-1

WHEREAS, Title 8 Chapter 8.04 of the 1993 Sangamon County Code, as amended, pertains to recycling; and

WHEREAS, due to the increase of construction materials, such as metal siding, being taken from construction sites and vacant homes and taken to recycling centers as scrap metal, it is in the best interest of Sangamon County to amend Title 8 Chapter 8.04, Article IV to require recycling centers to obtain additional information, including verification of the right to dispose of recyclable materials such as scrap metal, in order to assist law enforcement in the apprehension and prosecution of individuals engaging in theft of these materials;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 139th day of ~~September~~ August, 2011, that Title 8, Chapter 8.04, Article VI, Section 8.04.345 of the Sangamon County Code is hereby deleted and replaced with the revised Title 8, Chapter 8.04, Article VI, Section 8.04.345, to read as follows:

ARTICLE IV RECYCLING

8.04.345 Obligations of scrap operators


- (A) Scrap materials shall not be accepted from any person under 16 years of age. Prior to accepting scrap metal, scrap operators shall obtain the license plate number of the recycling client's vehicle.
- (B) Scrap operators must log the following information for each transaction:
 - (1) the date and time of the transaction; and
 - (2) the name of the seller; and
 - (3) the license plate number of the seller's vehicle; and
 - (4) the number and picture of the seller's state-issued driver's license or State or Federal-issued identification card; and
 - (5) the seller's mailing address as listed on the identification in subsection (B)(4) herein; and
 - (6) if the transaction is conducted on behalf of a business, the name and address of the business; and
 - (7) a description of the scrap materials; and
 - (8) the origin of the materials; and
 - (9) the amount paid to the seller.
- (C) Scrap operators shall pay for scrap metal via check if the transaction exceeds \$100 in value. shall pay for scrap metal via check if the transaction exceeds \$100 in value.


(D) Scrap operators are required to communicate with law enforcement personnel regarding the theft of scrap metal, including the quantity of material stolen, type of material, and other relevant information and are responsible for dissemination of the information to all other local scrap processors.


(E) Scrap operators shall keep documentation regarding each transaction on file for a period of at least 90 days after the transaction has been completed, and shall allow law enforcement personnel access to said documentation anytime during normal business hours without a search warrant.

(F) For purposes of this section only, aluminum cans are not considered scrap materials.
