Subcontract between Sangamon County Court Services, Invenile Probation & the Youth Services Bureau for Redeploy Illinois Services.

Effective July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016

A. DATE OF THE SUBCONTRACT

This agreement ("Subcontract") made the first day of July, 2015

B. PARTIES TO THE SUBCONTRACT

The Subcontract is by and between Sangamon County Court Services, Juvenile Probation with its principle office located at 200 South 9th Street, Room 308, Springfield. II. 62701 and Youth Service Bureau, with its principle office at 2901 Normandy Road, Springfield, II. 62703 hereinafter referred to as "YSB".

C. SERVICE CONTRACT TERM

This Subcontract shall be effective July 1, 2015 and expire June 30, 2016.

D. MAXIMUM PAYABLE UNDER SUBCONTRACT

The maximum payable under this Subcontract is \$160,976.00. These funds cannot be used to suppliant funding of existing services. "Suppliant" is to replace funding of a recipients existing program with funds from another state or federal grant.

E. INVOICING AND PAYMENT

Sangamon County Court Services, Juvenile Probation, shall make payments to the YSB upon receipt of invoice for services rendered under and in accordance with this contract. YSB will send Sangamon County Court Services, Juvenile Probation, an invoice monthly describing the number of youth enrolled and hours of mentoring provided. (Please see Attachment A for sample of invoice.) Sangamon County shall issue payment to the Youth Service Bureau with the first invoice and subsequent invoices being due within thirty days of the State of Illinois passing their SFY 2016 budget.





F. CONTRACT NON-ASSIGNABLE

This Subcontract shall not be assignable by either party without the written consent of the other, and any purported assignment without such consent shall be void. Either party may terminate this agreement without cause by providing 30 days written notice.

G. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES PROVIDED & OBLIGATIONS

The YSB agrees to provide the following, (a) Case Management and counseling for those youth participating in the Redeploy Program, (b) Individual therapy for those assessed and determined to be appropriate and necessary, not to exceed 4 hours a week, (c) Assigned a mentor not to exceed 40 hours per month, (d) Actively participate in meetings and teleconferences relating to the participating youth and/or Redeploy Services.

H. PROGRESS REPORTS

YSB will complete monthly progress reports and additional reports as requested and deemed necessary by Sangamon County Court Service, Juvenile Probation.

I. AUDIT/RETENTION OF RECORDS

The YSB shall maintain records and flies which adequately identify the source and application of funds provided for financially assisted activities, relating to the performance of the Subcontract, and necessary to support amounts charged to Sangamon County Court Services, Juvenile Probation under the contract. Records, including information stored in databases or other computer systems, shall be maintained by the YSB for a period not to exceed the youths 21st birthday, at which time some records from the file may be expunged and destroyed, keeping the identifying information indefinitely. Records maintained under this section shall be available for a financial compliance audit and on site program review by representatives of Sangamon County Court Services, Juvenile Probation, or other governmental auditors or funding entities related to Redeploy Illinois Programming.
