

RESOLUTION NO. 11-1

**WHEREAS**, an extensive flooding event is underway in Central Illinois and Sangamon County;

**WHEREAS**, Sangamon County citizens are facing significant repair and rebuilding costs from damage done to Sangamon County properties caused by the flooding;

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.56.080 of the Sangamon County Code provides for a declaration of a County Disaster Emergency by the Sangamon County Board and Sangamon County Board Chairman;


**WHEREAS**, a County Disaster Declaration allows the Sangamon County Board to temporarily suspend provisions of the County Code in reaction to the disaster;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the members of the Sangamon County Board this 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016 that:

- I. The Sangamon County Board declares that a County disaster emergency caused by the current flooding events exists.
- II. Pursuant to said declaration the fee's required under the following sections of the Sangamon County Code are waived until September 1, 2016 for properties affected by the current flooding event and for which the property owners, or another on their behalf, have applied for a Permit Fee Waiver Request with Sangamon County by March 1, 2016:
  1. Section 16.72.110 of the Sangamon County Code
  2. Section 5.24.020 of the Sangamon County Code
  3. Section 5.24.060 of the Sangamon County Code
  4. Section 15.05.200 of the Sangamon County Code

III. That Sangamon County will initiate a Voucher Program for the disposal of solid waste occurring as a result of the flood event for unincorporated Sangamon County and incorporated villages affected by the flood event.
