WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from Illinois Department of Public Health for the Covid-19 Crisis Grant 22-23 - Sangamon program in the amount of approximately \$310,441.00; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow Public Health to provide expanded public health workforce to support Covid-19 prevention, preparedness and response; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, Public Health Committee and the Finance Committee have approved the Public Health Department's request to apply for the Covid-19 Crisis Grant 22-23 - Sangamon grant and the committees recommend that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by Illinois Department of Public Health.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 8th day of March, 2022, approves the acceptance of the Covid-19 Crisis Grant 22-23 - Sangamon grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by Illinois Department of Public Health. The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.


