WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board believes that it is in the best interest of the general health, safety, comfort, and welfare of the people of Sangamon County, Illinois to adopt updated versions of building codes and

WHEREAS, Public Act 096-0778 was signed into law on August 28, 2009 amending the Energy Efficient Commercial Building Act by including residential buildings and amending the name of the act to the Energy Efficient Building Act. The new requirements for residential buildings became effective on January 29, 2010; and

WHEREAS, The Law requires all new commercial and residential construction for which a building permit application is received by a municipality or county to follow a comprehensive statewide energy conservation code. Renovations, alterations, additions, and repairs to most existing commercial and residential buildings must follow the Illinois Energy Conservation Code; and

WHEREAS, The Law requires design and construction professionals to follow the latest published edition of the International Energy Conservation Code which is currently the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code and the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air-conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) Standard 90.1, 2007 "Energy Standard for Buildings except Low-Rise Residential Buildings." Under the law, the Capital Development Board has the power to modify the Illinois Energy Conservation Code.

WHEREAS, the public act required that no unit of local government, may regulate energy efficient building standards in a manner that is less stringent than the provisions contained in the act; and

WHEREAS, the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code is available for adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board of Appeals has recommended that the Sangamon County Board adopt the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code; and

WHEREAS, the Public Health, Safety, and Zoning Committee of the Sangamon County Board recommends that the Sangamon County Board adopt the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 14th day of June, 2011, the Sangamon County Board amends the Sangamon County Code as follows:

15.05.070 Technical codes and public records adopted by these regulations.

New language

The International Energy Conservation Code 2009 Edition, as published by the International Code Council.

15.05.120.120 The following insertions, deletions, additions, or changes shall be made to the International Energy Conservation Code, 2006 *change to 2009 Edition.*

New language

- A. Section 101.1. Insert: Sangamon County Illinois.
- B. Plumbing reference. Whenever reference is made to the provisions of the International Plumbing Code, the reference shall instead be construed to be to the Illinois Plumbing Code, as referenced in section 15.05.070.
- C. Errata. The errata to the International Energy Conservation Code are adopted.
