

RESOLUTION NO. 12-1


WHEREAS, Public Act 100-0337, which was signed into law on August 25, 2017, permits the use of three election judges from five per precinct for General Primary Elections, with approval by resolution of the county board; and

WHEREAS, by employing three election judges per precinct as now allowed by law, Sangamon County would save approximately \$72,000 each General Primary Election while providing continued professional, efficient and timely processing of voters; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Election Oversight Committee recommends to authorize the Election Office to contract three election judges per precinct as now allowed by statute for General Primary Elections in Sangamon County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 12th day of December, 2017, hereby approve the use of three election judges from five per precinct for General Primary Elections in Sangamon County.
