

RESOLUTION ¹²⁻¹
CONCERNING THE USE OF COUNTY FUNDS FOR DEFENSE LOGISTICS AGENCY'S
LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT OFFICE PROGRAM 1033

WHEREAS, the United States Defense Logistics Agency administers Program 1033 through the Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) to provide obsolete or unneeded excess property from U.S. Military units for use by local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Sheriff desires to participate in this program to acquire such property and equipment at great cost savings to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board supports the acquisition of property and equipment through this program as a means to more cost effectively utilize the funds of Sangamon County Taxpayers while upholding the highest level of integrity for civilian law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, Section 5/3-10014 of the Illinois County Code (55 ILCS 5/3-10014) provides that "No money or funds shall be paid out of any county treasury, except in accordance with an order of the county board, or when payment is specially authorized by law to be made";

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County at its Regular Reconvened Adjourned September Session, assembled this 8th day of June, 2021, that it is the policy of SANGAMON COUNTY and the direction of its County Board that the County Treasurer shall not expend funds from the county treasury for the acquisition, insurance, maintenance, or storage of any **Armored Vehicles (Wheeled)**, which are defined as any wheeled vehicle either purpose-built or modified to provide ballistic protection to its occupants, such as a Mine-Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) vehicle or an Armored Personnel Carrier that may or may not have weapon-firing ports.
