

RESOLUTION NO. 14-1

**WHEREAS**, On June 14, 2006 the Sangamon County Board (Sangamon County) entered into an agreement with the New World Systems Corporation (New World) for the procurement of an integrated criminal justice system (ICJS), and

**WHEREAS**, a critical component of the ICJS is the Criminal Justice System Maintenance Service Agreement (SMSA), which covers the standard software maintenance support services provided by New World, and

**WHEREAS**, the SMSA between Sangamon County and New World will expire on August 31, 2012, and

**WHEREAS**, Sangamon County, the City of Springfield (Springfield) and the Sangamon County Emergency Telephone System Board (ETSB) are currently in negotiations with New World on a new joint SMSA that will include all three entities, and

**WHEREAS**, while those negotiations occur, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Sangamon County that the current SMSA be extended, and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, this 14th day of August, 2012 that the Sangamon County Board finds that an extension of the New World Criminal Justice System Maintenance Service Agreement (SMSA) is of vital importance to health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Sangamon County and hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Sangamon County Board to execute an agreement for extension of the same to December 31, 2012 under the same terms and conditions as currently exist.
