## RESOLUTION 14-1

WHEREAS, in June 2004 this County Board enacted Chapter 2.78 of the Sangamon County Code, regulating the political activities of the elected officers and employees of the County, commonly referred to as the County Ethics Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, this County Board deems the ethical conduct of this County's officers and employees to be of the highest importance; and

WHEREAS, in Chapter 2.44.300 pertaining to conflicts of interest, the county board seeks to further tighten requirements preventing employees and those of the county that hold an elected or appointed office governing the business of the county from accepting any political contributions from any business or entities, or persons (s) owning such entities that provide or are seeking to provide any contracted services to the county in excess of \$5000; and

WHEREAS, the addition of the amendment below to Sangamon County Code Chapter 2.44.300 will be titled E; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 13th day of November, 2012 that Chapter 2.44.300 of the Sangamon County Code is hereby amended by adding section E as listed below:

<u>2.44.300 E</u> No employee of Sangamon County who holds an elected or appointed office governing the business of the county shall accept any political contributions from any business or entities or person (s) owning such entities that provide or are seeking to provide any contracted services to the county in excess of \$5000. This will apply to all employees, elected and appointed officials, including the Sangamon County Board.
