INTER-GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT



BETWEEN
THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, ILLINOIS CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION AUTHORITY
AND
Sangamon County on behalf of the Sangamon County Circuit Court

The Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority (Grantor), with its principal office at 300 West Adams Street, Suite 200, Chicago, Illinois 60606, and Sangamon County on behalf of the Sangamon County Circuit Court (Grantee), with its principal office at 209 S. 9th St RM 204 Springfield, Illinois 62701-1968, hereby enter into this Inter-governmental Grant Agreement (Agreement), pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq. Grantor and Grantee are collectively referred to herein as "Parties" or individually as a "Party."

PART ONE – THE UNIFORM TERMS
RECITALS

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Parties to perform consistent with all Exhibits and attachments hereto and pursuant to the duties and responsibilities imposed by Grantor under the laws of the state of Illinois and in accordance with the terms, conditions and provisions hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual agreements contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the value, receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, the Parties hereto agree as follows:
