WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of Sangamon County Child Advocacy Center wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from Illinois Attorney General for the Child Advocacy Program program in the amount of approximately \$61,300.00; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow Sangamon County Child Advocacy Center to provide Services to child victims of crime, particularly child physical and sexual abuse; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, the Finance Committee has approved the Sangamon County Child Advocacy Center Department's request to apply for the Violent Crimes Victims Assistance grant and the committee recommends that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by Illinois Attorney General.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 11 day of July, 2023, approves the acceptance of the Violent Crimes Victims Assistance grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by Illinois Attorney General.

The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.


