

RESOLUTION NUMBER 15-1
A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE
SINGLE BIDDER RULE FOR THE ANNUAL TAX SALE

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Treasurer believes it to be in the best interests of the people of Sangamon County to conduct a fair and equitable annual tax sale, and desires to adopt a single bidder rule to help ensure fairness and equity; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Property Tax Code 35 ILCS 200/21-205 (b-5) provides that "The corporate authorities in any county with less than 275,000 inhabitants may, by ordinance, allow the county collector of that county to adopt such a single bidder rule."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sangamon County Board approves the use of a single bidder rule by the Sangamon County Treasurer, in accordance with 35 ILCS 200/21-205 (b-5).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Sangamon County Treasurer may require an affidavit to be signed by each registered tax buyer attesting to compliance with the single bidder rule.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the determination of whether registered entities are related so as to prohibit those entities from submitting duplicate bids in violation of the single bidder rule is at the sole and exclusive discretion of the County Treasurer or their designated representatives.
