WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Liquor Committee has considered and received testimony and argument for the allowance of employment of persons under 21 years but at least 19 years of age to deliver or handle alcoholic liquors during the course of their employ;

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board has considered the desirability of allowing persons 19 and 20 years of age to deliver or handle alcoholic liquors during the course of their employ;

WHEREAS, the County Board finds that allowing persons 19 or 20 years of age to deliver or handle alcoholic beverages during the course of their employ while under adult supervision;

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield now and for a period of time has allowed persons under the age of 21 to handle or deliver alcoholic beverages on licensed premises;

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County businesses operate under a competitive disadvantage based on their inability to employ a more diverse labor pool;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the members of the Sangamon County Board in session this 13th day of February, 2013 that the Sangamon County Alcoholic Beverages Ordinance Section 5.04.210(I) and 504.240 be amended as provided in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

EXHIBIT "A"

I. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as permitting any employee under the age of twenty-one to handle, mix sell, exchange, serve, or in any way take part in a licensee's business of selling alcoholic liquors draw, pour, or mix any alcoholic liquor on the licensed premises or make sales of any alcoholic liquor as an employee or gratuitously.

5.04.240 – Employment of Minors.

No licensee, agent or employee shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one to draw, pour or mix or serve any alcoholic liquor in the premises either as an employee or gratuitously. No licensee, his/her agent or employee shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one years to attend any bar to serve or dispense or in any other way to handle alcoholic liquor or make sales of any alcoholic liquor, including packaged liquor, upon his/her licensed premises. No licensee, agent, or employee shall permit any person under the age of nineteen to serve, attend any bar or in any way to handle alcoholic liquor including package liquor upon his/her licensed premises.
