

Resolution No. 15-1

**WHEREAS**, the Sangamon County Department of Community Resources (the Department) is seeking the approval of the Sangamon County Board (the Board) to provide 18-week Certified Nursing Assistant (C.N.A.) program tuition for students in the amount of \$40,000 to Lincoln Land Community College (LLCC) Adult Literacy program from 2018 CSBG Category D/Skills Training category funds,

**WHEREAS**, applicants are not eligible for the WIOA C.N.A. program due to multiple barriers,

**WHEREAS**, the program is comprised of a 2-week College-Ready Academy including 12 hours of financial literacy, 8 weeks of higher education math and reading and 8 weeks of Certified Nursing Assistant training and clinical course work,

**WHEREAS**, applicants for the program must demonstrate they will be able to benefit from the vocational training programs and or adult continuing education classes in which they are enrolled,

**WHEREAS**, the Department and LLCC will work jointly to provide case management and barrier reduction services to enrolled participants,

**WHEREAS**, the Department and LLCC have identified a pool of clients who are interested in C.N.A. training through orientations offered before each new cohort is selected.

**WHEREAS**, LLCC will provide Department-funded students with course work results,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois in session this 14<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2018 that the County is authorized to enter into a contract with LLCC to provide a comprehensive 18- week C.N.A. course to income-eligible customers in Sangamon County.
