WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures also require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health wishes to apply for and accept a grant from the Illinois Department of Public Health for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness – Menard County Grant in the amount of \$35,413.00; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow Sangamon County Department of Public Health to quickly and effectively respond to and recover from 21st century threats by enhancing communications, improving resource management, and building medical surge capacity by assessing, prioritizing, building, and exercising the necessary resource elements, tasks, and functions of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) most current version of the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Capabilities National Standards; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, the Public Health, Solid Waste and Zoning Committee and the Finance Committee have approved the request of the Sangamon County Department of Public Health to apply for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness -Sangamon County Grant from the Illinois Department of Public Health; and the Committees recommend that the County Board approve acceptance of this grant, if awarded by the Illinois Department of Public Health.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 11th day of June, 2019, approves the acceptance of the Public Health Emergency Preparedness - Menard County Grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by the Illinois Department of Public Health. The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement of for this grant.
