


RESOLUTION # 19-1

WHEREAS, pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/11-2, the County Board shall at its regular meeting in June, divide its election precincts which contain more than 800 registered voters;

WHEREAS, pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/11-2, in order to situate each precinct within a single district or ward, the County Board shall change the boundaries of election precincts after each decennial census as soon as is practicable following the completion of congressional and legislative redistricting;

WHEREAS, the County Board finds it necessary to adjust the precinct lines of several precincts, to be determined by the County Clerk, with the advice and assistance of the Election Office, in an effort to reduce the number of registered voters within each precinct and to reduce the number of split districts within certain precincts, as a result of redistricting following the 2010 decennial census;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the members of the County Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 2011, approve the realignment of the precincts meeting the above requirements and to be detailed and presented to the board at a later date, as soon as is practical and once analysis has been completed on the impact of the 2010 redistricting of congressional, legislative, representative and county board district boundaries.
