
**WHEREAS**, certain Sangamon County Highway Department employee's salaries are paid from the County Motor Fuel Tax Fund; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Department of Transportation's policies allow the County's cost for Social Security and the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund to be paid from the County Motor Fuel Tax Fund for those employees whose salaries are paid from the County Motor Fuel Tax Fund; and,

**WHEREAS**, the estimated employer's cost of Social Security and the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund for those Sangamon County Highway Department employees paid out of the County Motor Fuel Tax Fund is \$275,000.00 for FY 2017.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County, at its **Regular Reconvened Adjourned September Session**, assembled this 13<sup>th</sup> day of December, A.D. 2016, that there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$275,000.00 from the County Motor Fuel Tax Fund to pay the employer's share of the cost of Social Security and the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, known as County Section 17-00000-00-RF for those employees whose salaries are paid from the County Motor Fuel Tax Fund.
