

RESOLUTION 1-1

WHEREAS, plans are prepared for the rehabilitation of Spaulding Orchard Road (County Highway 23) from Curran Road to IL Route 4 and South Williamsville Road (County Highway 31) from Wolf Creek Road to McGrath Street; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of construction is \$2,130,700; and,

WHEREAS, the project will be funded with eighty percent (80%) Federal Surface Transportation Rural funds, \$339,700 of State Truck Access Route Program funds and the remaining with County Matching funds; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Sangamon County to execute a "Local Agency Agreement for Federal Participation" with the State of Illinois for projects using Federal Funds; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois by its General Assembly has enacted the Illinois Vehicle Code; and,

WHEREAS, 625 ILCS 5/1-126.1 provides that local authorities may designate Class II or Class III highways within their jurisdiction, and in accordance with 625 ILCS 5/15-111(f), weight limitations shall be designated by appropriate signs and placed on such highways; and,

WHEREAS, Sangamon County is desirous of providing a truck route for the purpose of accommodating a load limit of 80,000 pounds:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County at its **Regular Statutory Meeting**, assembled this 11th day of June, A.D., 2019, that the "Local Agency Agreement for Federal Participation" between Sangamon County and the Illinois Department of Transportation which depicts the breakdown of the funds for construction, be approved; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County that the Chairman of the County Board is hereby authorized and directed to sign said Agreement on behalf of Sangamon County; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the portions of Spaulding Orchard Road (County Highway 23) beginning at the intersection with Curran Road (County Highway 18) and extending to IL Route 4 for 3.5 miles be designated as a Class III Truck Route.
