WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of CHILD ADVOCACY wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from CHILDRENS ADVOCACY CENTERS OF ILLINOIS (VOCA) for the CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER program in the amount of approximately \$274,375.09; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow THE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER to provide DIRECT PROGRAMS AND SERVICES TO VICTIMS OF CHILD ABUSE; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, the FINANCE COMMITTEE has approved the CHILD ADVOCACY Department's request to apply for the CHILDRENS ADVOCACY CENTERS OF ILLINOIS (VOCA) grant and the committees recommend that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by CHILDRENS ADVOCACY CENTERS OF ILLINOIS (VOCA).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 8<sup>TH</sup> day of JANUARY, 2019, approves the acceptance of the CHILDRENS ADVOCACY CENTERS OF ILLINOIS (VOCA), grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by CHILDRENS ADVOCACY CENTERS OF ILLINOIS (VOCA). The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.
