

Court Services Department Resolution for Supplemental Grant Funding

WHEREAS, Sangamon County procedures require the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grant funding from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County Probation and Court Services Department received approval from the Finance Committee on February 5, 2019, to apply for supplemental funding through Adult Redeploy Illinois through the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County procedures requires that the acceptance of grant funding of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full Sangamon County Board; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has approved the acceptance of a 1-year Adult Redeploy Illinois grant award in the amount of \$373,415.00 from the State of Illinois to support the operations of Sangamon County's three (3) Problem-Solving Courts (Drug Court, Mental Health Recovery Court and Veteran's Court); and

WHEREAS, Adult Redeploy Illinois is offering supplemental funding of \$50,000.00 for existing Adult Redeploy Illinois sites for SFY2019, which would be used to implement a Sangamon County Treatment Integrated Trauma Treatment (SCC-ITT) Program through Southern Illinois University-School of Medicine (SIU-SOM) to pro-actively address trauma for participants within our Problem-Solving Courts to improve graduation and recidivism rates, and the Committee is now submitting this resolution to the Sangamon County Board for its approval for Sangamon County to accept this supplemental grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 5th day of February, 2019, authorizes the County Board Chairman to accept the supplemental grant funding detailed above and to sign required grant documents to execute the grant agreement.

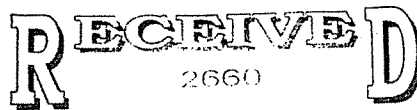
