WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of Court Services wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from U.S. Department of Justice-Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Prison Rape Elimination Act program in the amount of approximately \$37,354.00; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow Court Services to provide a mechanism to receive technical assistance for Juvenile Detention Center to be PREA certified; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, Court Services Committee and the Finance Committee have approved the Court Services Department's request to apply for the Prison Rape Elimination Act grant and the committees recommend that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by U.S. Department of Justice-Bureau of Justice Assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 9 day of June, 2020, approves the acceptance of the Prison Rape Elimination Act grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by U.S. Department of Justice-Bureau of Justice Assistance. The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.

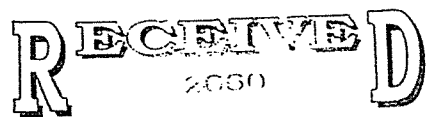
