

RESOLUTION 25-1

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY AUXILIARY LIQUOR PERMIT

WHEREAS, the coronavirus pandemic has significantly curtailed businesses operated by Sangamon County liquor licensees permitted to serve alcoholic beverages inside the permanent structures on their premises, thereby adversely impacting these licensees' incomes; and

WHEREAS, one means of increasing these licensees' business and incomes while still maintaining necessary social distancing is to increase the square footage of the area in which they may serve alcoholic beverages; and

WHEREAS, an economical manner of increasing the square footage is to also allow these licensees to conduct sales outside of the permanent structures on their premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 9th day of June, 2020, that there shall exist a Temporary Auxiliary Liquor Permit, which shall be issued under the following conditions:

1. Upon application and payment of an investigation and application fee of \$100, an existing holder of a Class 1AA, 1BB, 1PC, 3AA, and 1WW license may be issued a Temporary Auxiliary Liquor Permit.

2. A Temporary Auxiliary Liquor Permit shall, upon issuance, entitle an existing holder of a Class 1AA, 1BB, 1PC, 3AA, and 1WW license to sell alcoholic liquor as authorized inside their premises on the property where a licensee's permanent structure is located under the following conditions:

- a) A temporary fence or other similar structure made of wood, roping or other similar material, must be erected to enclose the whole area in which alcoholic liquors are served, poured, mixed, or consumed. The enclosed area must be at least twenty feet from any intersection. The fencing shall be designed to separate the licensee's patrons from the general public.
- b) Access into the outside area shall be from the permanent structure only and no access shall be permitted from the sidewalk or adjoining property. Emergency exits must be provided. Exceptions may apply upon approval.
- c) The sound of any music emitting from any source or location is prohibited in the outside area.
- d) No sales or dispensing of alcoholic liquor may be made from the outside area or permanent structure to any person upon adjoining property, public street, sidewalk or alley. Alcoholic liquor served in open containers may not be removed from the outside area or permanent structure.
- e) Adequate security must be provided by the licensee.
- f) Outside area activities may be limited to the restrictions of the license.
- g) Issuance of a Temporary Auxiliary Liquor Permit to a licensee shall be treated separately from the licensee's primary license and shall be subject to suspension or revocation by the Commissioner for just cause.

3. The term of an initial Temporary Auxiliary Liquor Permit issued to a licensee and all subsequent renewals of that permit shall be fifteen days. On or before the expiration of any such fifteen-day term, an



eligible licensee desiring to continue operating under the provisions allowed by the initial permit or any subsequent renewal must again apply for a renewal permit; however, no additional investigation and application fee shall be imposed after the initial \$100 fee required by paragraph 1 (above) has been paid.

4. No Temporary Auxiliary Liquor Permit shall be issued after the County Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, issues a resolution stating that the coronavirus disaster the County Board, on March 30, 2020, declared extended, has ended.
