WHEREAS, bids were opened in the office of the County Engineer on October 18, 2010 for the re-construction and drainage improvement of Mansion Road in Curran Township; and,

WHEREAS, five (5) bids were received with the low bid being submitted by County Contractors, Quincy, Illinois in the amount of \$471,120.06; and,

WHEREAS, the low bid is below the approved Engineer's Estimate of Cost; and,

WHEREAS, the Township proposes to use local Funds to pay for its portion estimated to be \$318,122.40 and the County proposes to use \$152,997.66 of County Bridge Funds for its portion.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County at its **REGULAR RECONVENED SEPTEMBER SESSION**, assembled this 9th day of November, A.D., 2010, that the low bid from County Contractors in the amount of \$471,120.06 for the re-construction and drainage improvement of Mansion Road in Curran Township be accepted; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County that the Chairman of the County Board is hereby authorized and directed to sign said contract on behalf of Sangamon County.


