**WHEREAS**, plans are prepared for a roadway improvement on Woodside Road (County Highway 23) from west of Illinois Route 4 to east of Chatham Road; and,

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost of construction is \$5,630,000.00; and,

**WHEREAS**, the project will be funded with eighty percent (80%) Federal Surface Transportation Urban and Rural funds, \$213,475.00 of State Truck Access Route Program funds and the remaining balance, estimated to be \$912,525 with County Federal Aid Matching funds; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for Sangamon County to execute a "Local Agency Agreement for Federal Participation" with the State of Illinois for projects using Federal Funds.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County at its **Regular Statutory Meeting**, assembled this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, A.D., 2017, that the "Local Agency Agreement for Federal Participation" between Sangamon County and the Illinois Department of Transportation which depicts the breakdown of the funds for construction, be approved; and,


