

RESOLUTION 3-1

WHEREAS, Sangamon County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Sangamon County; and,

WHEREAS, the 2022 Sangamon County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan Update, hereinafter "the Plan", has been prepared by the Springfield-Sangamon County Regional Planning Commission (SSCRPC) through the Sangamon County Multi-jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, the Plan has been prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 CFR Part 201; and,

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Sangamon County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and,

WHEREAS, adoption by Sangamon County demonstrates their commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Plan; and,

WHEREAS, Sangamon County is a local unit of government that has afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input to the Plan and the actions in the Plan; and,

WHEREAS, upon final acceptance of the Plan by FEMA, the Plan will be available to the public on the websites of Sangamon County and the SSCRPC with a paper copy retained in the SSCRPC offices; and,

WHEREAS, Sangamon County has reviewed the Plan and affirms to participate in the Workgroup that will review the Plan every year and update it no less than every five years;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sangamon County Board that the Sangamon County adopts the Plan as this jurisdiction's Multi-hazard Mitigation Plan, and resolves to execute the actions in the Plan.
