

Resolution No. 4-1

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Department of Public Health (SCDPH) does not have electronic medical record capability; and

WHEREAS, SCDPH currently maintains over 250,000 medical records, some of which like immunizations, must by law be kept permanently; and

WHEREAS, Prairie Cardiovascular has moved to electronic medical records and subsequently are removing their rolling space saver files; and

WHEREAS, Prairie Cardiovascular approached SCDPH and offered the Department their space saver filing units for the cost of removing them; and


WHEREAS, the cost for removing and installing the filing system at SCDPH would be \$15,676, and would provide the Department with triple its current filing space needs; and

WHEREAS, the cost for this system, if new, would be over \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board of Health has approved this purchase with funds currently in the Department's budget;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2010, agrees with the Board of Health and approves the purchase and installation of the space saver filing system, and also wishes to extend its appreciation to Prairie Cardiovascular for helping the County increase its filing capability at a very low cost, and at the same time, helped to facilitate recycling of business materials, which is in the spirit of the County's Solid Waste Plan.
