**WHEREAS**, in 2001 the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, through its Open Land Trust Program, purchased a 38-mile corridor of abandoned railroad right-of-way from the Union Pacific Railroad Company; and,

**WHEREAS**, approximately 30 miles of the above-mentioned 38-mile corridor is located in Sangamon County; and,

**WHEREAS**, it was the intent of the Illinois Department of Natural Resources to acquire the abandoned right-of-way to provide an area for the development of a trail for recreation and non-motorized transportation with local jurisdictions, such as counties, to partner with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources in the construction of the trail; and,

**WHEREAS**, the County Board of Sangamon County is desirous of developing and maintaining the Sangamon Valley Greenway corridor as a trail through Sangamon County to provide an area for recreation and non-motorized transportation; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources has prepared an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Illinois Department of Natural Resources and Sangamon County setting out the responsibilities and other details for the Bike Trail Development between the Illinois Department of Natural Resources and Sangamon County; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County at its Regular Reconvened Adjourned September Session, assembled this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, A.D., 2020 that the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Illinois Department of Natural Resources and Sangamon County for the project known as the Sangamon Valley Trail, Phase 4 is hereby approved; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County that the Chairman of the County Board is hereby authorized and directed to sign said Agreement on behalf of Sangamon County.
