

Resolution # 6-1

WHEREAS, pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/13-10, the compensation of election judges shall be fixed by the respective county boards; and

WHEREAS, the current pay for an Election Judge in Sangamon County is set at \$150 base pay, plus \$50 for all who have been certified as having satisfactorily completed the training course within the two years preceding the day of election, for a total of \$200; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 103-0008, effective June 7, 2023, amends the Election Code at 10 ILCS 5/13-10 requiring that the portion of an election judges' daily compensation reimbursement by the State Board of Elections is increased by an additional \$20 (currently \$45) to each election judge who serves; and

WHEREAS, said Public Act states that this increase may not be used by the County to reduce its portion of a judge's compensation; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Clerk, wishes as a result of Public Act 103-0008, to increase the base compensation for Judges of Election by \$20 per day; and

WHEREAS, this increase will aid in the recruitment and retention of quality election judges in Sangamon County and due to the reimbursement increase, will not cost the County any additional expense; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 8th day of August, 2023, approves the \$20 increase to the compensation of Judges of Election, establishing base pay at \$170 without training and \$220 with training.
