# GRANTING A REZONING AND VARIANCES FOR CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1616 PULLIAM ROAD, SPRINGFIELD SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has presented to the Sangamon County Board, Sangamon County, Illinois, its Findings of Fact and Recommendation that the Sangamon County Board grant an amendment and variances to the Sangamon County Zoning Ordinance with respect to the following described property, to-wit:

Part of the North one-half (1/2) of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of the Northwest quarter (1/4) of Section 20, Township 16 North, Range 5 West of the Third Principal Meridian, Sangamon County, Illinois. Containing 10.46 acres, more or less.

WHEREAS, the Petitioner, Elizabeth A. Mendenhall as Trustee for Norma T. & Robert Lee Pulliam Trust, has petitioned the Sangamon County Board for: proposed Parcel 1, a rezoning from "A" Agricultural District to "R-1" Single-Family Residence District with a variance of Section 17.04 to allow the lot depth to be greater than two and one-half (2 ½) times the lot width; and, for proposed Parcel 2, a variance of Section 17.38.030 to allow one (1) parcel less than forty (40) acres to allow the property to be divided and a single-family residence constructed; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at the Sangamon County Building on **January 16**, **2014** after proper notice was posted on said property and given by news publication, as is required by said Ordinance, and all procedural and jurisdictional requirements of the Sangamon County Zoning Ordinance have been met; and

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WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Zoning Board of Appeals has presented to the Sangamon County Board of Sangamon County its Findings of Fact and Recommendation that the Sangamon County Board grant the rezoning and variances; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board does hereby adopt the recommendation of the Sangamon County Zoning Board of Appeals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session assembled this 13<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2014 that the request for: proposed Parcel 1, a rezoning from "A" Agricultural District to "R-1" Single-Family Residence District with a variance of Section 17.04 to allow the lot depth to be greater than two and one-half (2 ½) times the lot width; and, for proposed Parcel 2, a variance of Section 17.38.030 to allow one (1) parcel less than forty (40) acres to allow the property to be divided and a single-family residence constructed on the above described property is hereby approved.

#### RECOMMENDATION OF THE BOARD OF APPEALS

- 1. That said Board has jurisdiction to consider the petition filed herein.
- 2. That the above-captioned petitioner(s) is the owner(s) and/or has a beneficial interest in, contract to purchase, or is the County Board Member representing the property commonly known as: **1616 Pulliam Road, Springfield, IL 62707** and more particularly described as:

- 7. That required findings and standards of the Sangamon County Board of Appeals are accurately stated on the attached exhibit(s).
- 8. The evidence adduced at the hearing **does** support the proposition that the adoption of the proposed **rezoning and variances** is in the public interest and is not solely in the interest of the petitioner(s).

Address: 1616 Pulliam Road, Springfield

(i) Existing uses of property within the general area of the property in question.

To the north is timber and cropland. To the east, south and west are single-family residences.

(ii) The zoning classification of property within the general area of the property in question.

There is City R-1 to the east and south. To the west and north is Agricultural zoning.

The suitability of the property in question to the uses permitted under the existing zoning classification.

The Land Evaluation and Site Assessment score of 142 indicates the property is deemed acceptable for non-agricultural development.

(iv) The trend of development, within the vicinity since the property was originally classified.

The area has remained stable with several single-family residences built in the immediate area.

### SANGAMON COUNTY RECOMMENDED - STANDARDS FOR VARIATIONS

Address: 1616 Pulliam Road, Springfield

The Zoning Board of Appeals shall not recommend to the Sangamon County Board that the regulations of this ordinance be varied as authorized in F. (1) hereof, unless it shall make findings of fact based upon the evidence presented to it in each specified case:

(i) that the property in question cannot be economically used or yield a reasonable return, if permitted to be used only for the conditions allowed by the regulations.

The request is being made to facilitate division of the property so the family can build a single-family residence and divide the property to satisfy the requirements of a trust.

(ii) that the plight of the owner is due to circumstances unique to the property and not generally applicable to other property in the area.

There are unique circumstances in that the property is being divided to satisfy the requirements of a trust.

(iii) that the variation, if granted, will not alter the essential character of the locality, impair an adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property, increase the congestion of traffic, or diminish or impair property values in the locality.

No negative impact is anticipated.
