WHEREAS, the Springfield Rail Improvement Project will require land acquisition from Sangamon County (County) in order to accommodate the expansion off the 10th Street rail corridor; and

WHEREAS, part of that land acquisition will include the structure located at 1001 East Monroe Street, Springfield, Illinois, which is the present location of the Sangamon County Child Advocacy Center (CAC); and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that the CAC will need to be relocated at a suitable site that not only meets the current needs of the CAC but will also allow for future growth and expansion in order to accommodate a growing caseload; and

WHEREAS, the County formed an ad hoc committee consisting of County Board members, the State's Attorney, CAC staff, Building and Grounds staff, Information Services staff, and a representative of the Board of Directors of the Friends of the Sangamon County Child Advocacy Center; and

WHEREAS, the ad hoc committee has reviewed numerous parcels throughout the central area of Springfield; and

WHEREAS, the committee has determined that the most suitable site for relocation is the parcel located at 1101 East Monroe Street, Springfield, Illinois, due to its proximity to the Sangamon County Complex, its affordable purchase price and its current building layout; and

WHEREAS, the asking price for the property was \$199,000.00 and the County has negotiated a purchase price of \$149,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the County's cost to purchase the new site and to make improvements to the building will be offset by a financial contribution from the Friends of the Sangamon County Child Advocacy Center and from funds derived from the sale of the current location as part of the Springfield Rail Improvement Project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the members of the Sangamon County Board in session this 9th day of February, 2016, that the County Board has authorized
